Executive Summary

The research project EUROJUSTIS (Scientific Indicators of Confidence in Justice: Tools for Policy Assessment), which is funded primarily by the European Commission from the 7th Framework Programme for Research, is designed to provide EU institutions and Member States with new indicators for assessing public confidence in justice.

Under WP2 'Review of Need: State-of-the-art Indicators of Public Confidence in Justice for Policy Assessment', task 2.2. 'Literature Review', each of the EUROJUSTIS project partners compiled a list of scientific publications from its country, relevant to the two major topic of research – confidence in justice and fear of crime. In addition, bibliographies for German-speaking countries, Nordic countries and the US were prepared by consortium members.

The bibliography, contained in this Deliverable, compiles all contributions from consortium members and was maintained and regularly updated during the course of the project. As work package leader, the Center for the Study of Democracy prepared and arranged the initial compilation of country bibliographies and was responsible for collecting periodic updates and feeding them into the Deliverable.

This final version of the bibliography is arranged into alphabetical and reverse chronological order, with publications in the Cyrillic alphabet listed separately.
